## 2010 Clinical Outcomes

- 100% of patients or their caregivers felt that Ovelle and/or Prairie were **valuable** to their therapy program.
- 100% felt Ovelle and/or Prairie helped them **work harder** in therapy.
- 97.76% felt Ovelle and/or Prairie helped them **achieve their goals faster**.
- 99.37% of the therapists felt Ovelle and/or Prairie were valuable to their patient's therapy program.
- 99.36% of the therapists felt Ovelle and/or Prairie made their patients work harder in therapy.
- 98.76% of the therapists felt Ovelle and/or Prairie helped their patient achieve his/her goals faster.
